

Putting on the Whole Armor of God Prayer Decree

Father in the name of Jesus, Your Word Says in Ephesians 6:13-18

¹³ Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm. ¹⁴ Stand your ground, putting on the belt of truth and the body armor of God's righteousness. ¹⁵ For shoes, put on the peace that comes from the Good News so that you will be fully prepared. ¹⁶ In addition to all of these, hold up the shield of faith to stop the fiery arrows of the devil. ¹⁷ Put on salvation as your helmet, and take the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers for all believers everywhere

In the name of Jesus, I take the complete armor of God to resist the enemy whenever he attacks and stand my ground on the evil day of danger, and having done all to stand firmly in place, I hold my ground.

I tie the belt of truth around my waist. Your Word, Oh God, is truth. Father, sanctify me according to your Word and remind me, through the Holy Spirit, of the truth that destroys the lies of sin.

Lord, Your Word says in Romans 5:1 –

I plant God's Word deep in my heart so I will always be ready to cut down lies with His truth. I will continue to pray in the spirit throughout the day and intercede for all Christians as the Holy Spirit prompts me. And, I believe that the Holy Spirit is interceding on my behalf according to my prayers.
