# The Decrees of Romans 8

### Heavenly Father, In the name of Jesus, your word says in Romans 8: 1-4

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. <sup>2</sup> For in Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit of life set you free from the law of sin and death. <sup>3</sup> For what the law was powerless to do in that it was weakened by the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful man, as an offering for sin. He thus condemned sin in the flesh, <sup>4</sup> so that the righteous standard of the law might be fulfilled in us, who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.

I declare there is no condemnation because I am found in Christ Jesus. The law of the Spirit of life has set me free from the law of sin and death. God sent His Son Jesus in the flesh as an offering to clear me of my sins as the law itself was powerless to do, so that the righteous standard of the law might be fulfilled in me. I declare I do not walk according to the flesh but according to the spirit.

## **Your Word says in Romans 8: 5-8**

<sup>5</sup>Those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh; but those who live according to the Spirit set their minds on the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup>The mind of the flesh is death, but the mind of the Spirit is life and peace, <sup>7</sup> because the mind of the flesh is hostile to God: It does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. <sup>8</sup> Those controlled by the flesh cannot please God. <sup>9</sup> You, however, are controlled not by the flesh, but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.

I declare I do not live according to the flesh because I do not set my mind on the things of the flesh which cannot please God and leads to death. The mind of the flesh is hostile to God because it does not submit to God's law nor can it do so. I live by the Spirit because my mind is set on the things of the Spirit which are life and peace. I am not controlled by the flesh but by the spirit of God because I belong to Jesus Christ. It is no longer I who live but Christ who lives within me.

#### **Your Word says in Romans 8: 12-14**

<sup>12</sup> Therefore, brothers, we have an obligation, but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. <sup>13</sup> For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. <sup>14</sup> For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God.

I declare I do not live by the flesh for doing so leads to death. I declare that by the Spirit I have put to death the deeds of my flesh so that I may live. I am led by the Spirit of God and I am a son of God.

### Father God, In Jesus' name, your Word in Romans 8: 18-27 says,

<sup>18</sup> I consider that our present sufferings are not comparable to the glory that will be revealed in us. <sup>19</sup> The creation waits in eager expectation for the revelation of the sons of God. <sup>20</sup> For the creation was subjected to futility, not by its own will, but because of the One who subjected it, in hope <sup>21</sup> that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to decay and brought into the glorious freedom of the children of God.

<sup>22</sup> We know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until the present time. <sup>23</sup> Not only that, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. <sup>24</sup>For in this hope we were saved; but hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what he can already see? <sup>25</sup> But if we hope for what we do not yet see, we wait for it patiently.

<sup>26</sup> In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know how we ought to pray, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groans too deep for words. <sup>27</sup> And He who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

I declare that my present sufferings are not comparable to the glory that will be revealed in me. I have been set free from bondage which leads to decay and brought into the glorious freedom of God. The Spirit helps me in my weakness for I do not always know how to pray but the Spirit interecedes for me with groans too deep for words. God searches my heart and knows the mind of the Spirit and therefore the Spirit intercedes for me according to the will of God.

#### Your Word says in Romans 8:28-34,

<sup>28</sup> And we know that God works all things together for the good of those who love Him, who are called according to His purpose. <sup>29</sup> For those God foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brothers. <sup>30</sup> And those He predestined, He also called; those He called, He also justified; those He justified, He also glorified.

<sup>31</sup> What then shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? <sup>32</sup> He who did not spare His own Son but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, freely give us all things? <sup>33</sup> Who will bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. <sup>34</sup> Who is there to condemn us? For Christ Jesus, who died, and more than that was raised to life, is at the right hand of God—and He is interceding for us.

I declare and agree that there is no problem in my life too big for God. All things work together for good because I love Him and have been called according to His purpose. He freely gives me all things. God foreknew and predestined me to be conformed to the image of His Son so that I may justify and bring glory to Him through His Son Jesus Christ. Christ died for my sins and was raised to life and is at the right hand of God and intercedes for me therefore nobody can be against me because Christ is for me and will never leave me or forsake me.

## Lord God, your Word says in Romans 8:35-39,

<sup>35</sup> Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall trouble or distress or persecution or famine or nakedness or danger or sword? <sup>36</sup> As it is written:

"For Your sake we face death all day long; we are considered as sheep to be slaughtered."

<sup>37</sup> No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. <sup>38</sup> For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor principalities, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, <sup>39</sup> neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

I declare that although we face death all day long, that nothing -not death nor life, neither angels or principalities, neither in the present or in the future, nor will any powers, regardless of depth or height, or anything else in all creation will ever be able to separate me from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus my Lord.

Thank you, Lord Father in Heaven for your Son Jesus, for being my rock and savior, for being patient with me and showing me your infinite love and mercy, for allowing me to declare your Holy Word for all of my needs. Thank you for calming my worries and always reminding me in the Spirit that you are for me and that nothing can ever separate your love from me.
